

2020-2021 WiSE Women of Color in STEM Pilot Career Preparation Program



Call for Nominations

Nominations due by September 1, 2020

WiSE is now accepting nominations for a pilot WiSE Women of Color in STEM (WWoCS) Career Preparation Program (CPP). This new program will provide a venue where undergraduate women of color in STEM can develop a road map for academic and career success. Nominations may be submitted by faculty or students who wish to self-nominate.

Eligibility:

- Participants must be women undergraduate students in STEM in their sophomore or junior year
- Participants must identify as a woman of color

Key elements of the program:

- Small stipend and certificate award for a one-year commitment
- Monthly activities and resources focusing on professional skills, networking, and community building
- Opportunity to develop and receive feedback on an early portfolio package, including a resume/CV, personal statement, and career plan

Nominations should include:

- Student's name and contact information
- Discipline and primary department
- Year in degree program
- Nominator's role (advisor, mentor) and contact information; for self-nominations, please provide the contact info of your primary academic or research advisor
- Brief statement about the student's coursework, research, and strengths
- Comment on the availability of the student to participate in at least five activities per year
